




## BOOK 1: THE PANGOLINS




## BOOK 2: THE ELEPHANTS




## BOOK 3: THE GIRAFFES




## BOOK 4: THE BABOONS




## BOOK 5: THE LIONS




## BOOK 6: THE OSTRICHES




